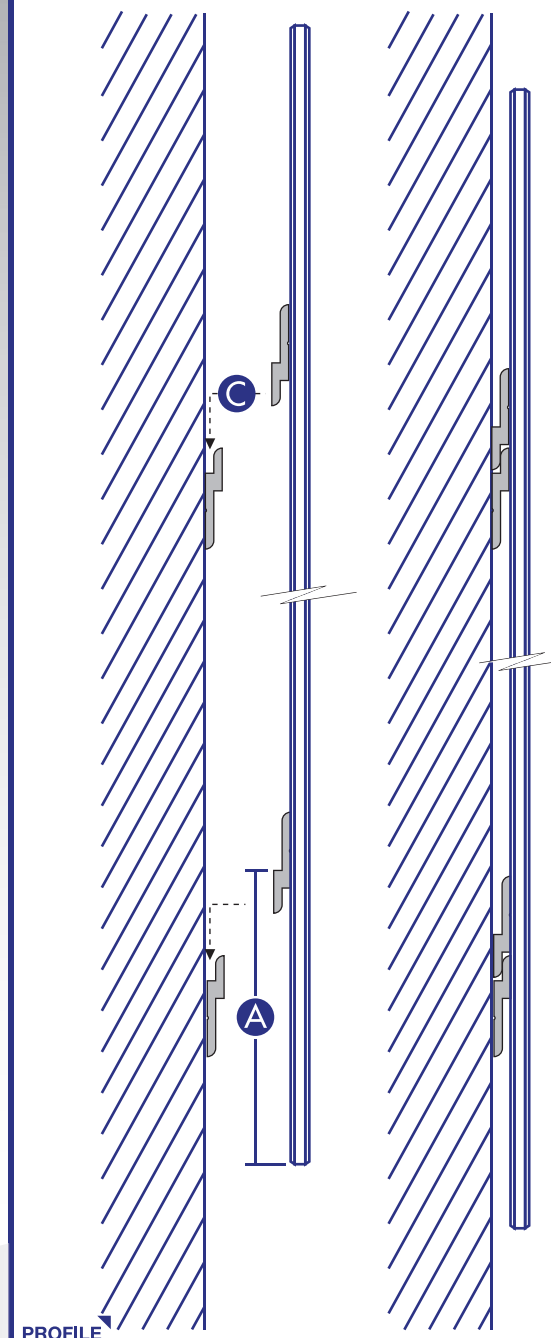

**INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION**

It is important to find the wall studs to install the board as securely and solidly as possible.

It is also important to make sure the wall you want to hang the board on is flat and not curved.

Determine the desired board height.

Measure the distance between the bottom of the board and the floor. Add this measurement to the distance indicated in the illustration **A** to determine the height of the first mounting bar and mark with a pencil.

Then, measure 24 in. up from that point to find the position of the second mounting bar. Mark it with a pencil.

Before screwing in the mounting bars, make sure they are level. **B**

Predrill the mounting bars based on the position of the studs.

If the mounting bars cannot be attached to the studs, predrill the wall at the predetermined locations to add screw anchors.

Screw in the mounting bars at the marked locations. Once on the wall, make sure the mounting bars are level and not bent by the pressure of the screws.

Apply a drop of silicone to the ends of the mounting bars to stabilize the glass board once in place. Now all you have to do is attach the glass board.

At least 2 people are needed for this step. **C**
